Our World

Concepts: Friendship, Tolerance, Liberty, Hope

Big questions:

- How can we make our world better?
- Why should we be tolerant of others?
- What makes a good friend?
- How can we help the environment?
- What do you hope for the future?

Subjects:

Geography: We will be comparing a village in the UK with a village elsewhere in the world, naming and locating the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans and learning about compass directions.

RE:

What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?
What is the Good News Jesus brings?

ART and DT: Linking to the geography topics we will look at African art and artists and create our own. We will also **BE** designing and building our own instruments.

English:

We will be writing our own journey story based on Meerkat Mail, having a go at letter writing and writing our own eco version of a traditional tale.

Mathematics:

Year 1 will cover multiplication, division, fractions and start to look at numbers to 100 and time
Year 2 will consolidate all the four operations and fractions and move onto learning time including quarter to and quarter past on an analogue clock and some weighing and measuring.

Science: We will be finding out about plant lifecycles and animal food chains.

PE: Track and field in preparation for Sports Day, tennis, cricket and skipping.

PSHE and RSE: Changing me is the Jigsaw topic for this term and it covers the Human lifecycle.

Music: West African call and response and singing songs from around the world.

Computing: We will be learning how to create a stop-animation project.
