The chicks left Early Years today after helping the children to learn about life cycles. Some of the hens will now be living with Mrs Hiscoe and Mrs Lewis.



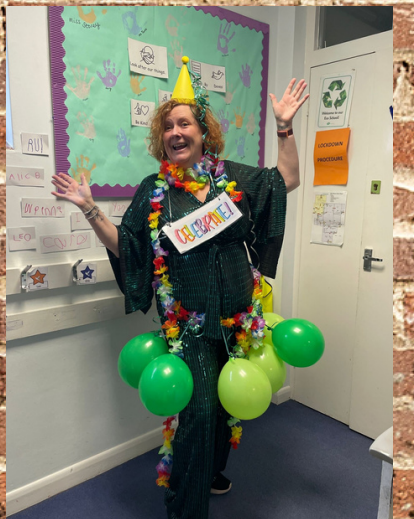
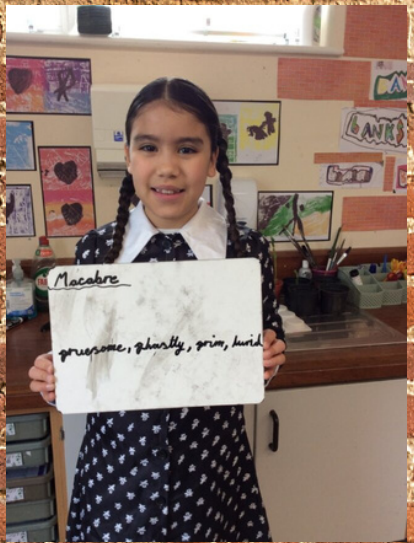
The Infant School received a fire safety talk from Mr Pipe before starting their own Great Fire.
