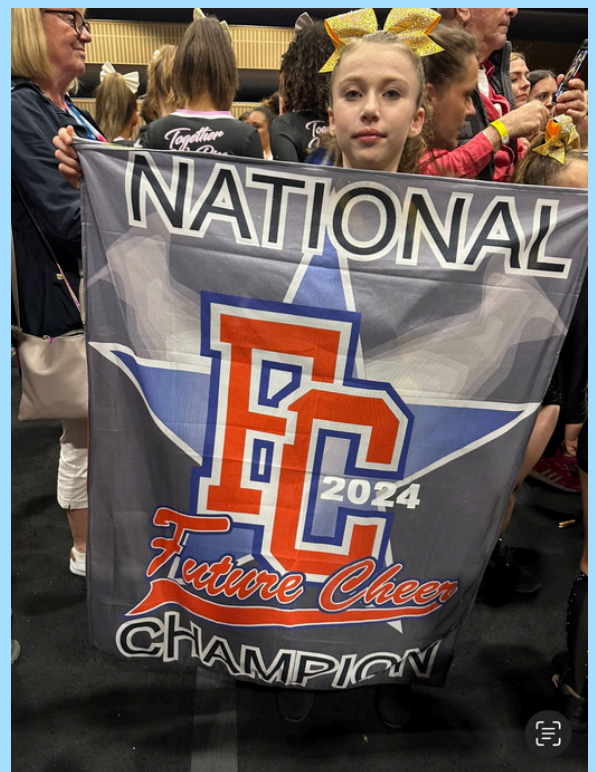

FRESHLY HOMEMADE BREAD - We cook bread daily and also use flavoured breads to bring new flavours to your children's palates.
