It has been lovely to open our doors to the parents for the welcome meetings and reading workshop and we look forward to welcoming you to other events as the term progresses.

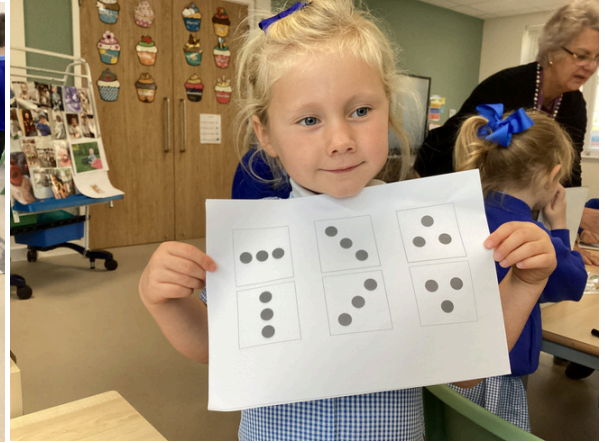
## SPORTING EVENTS
