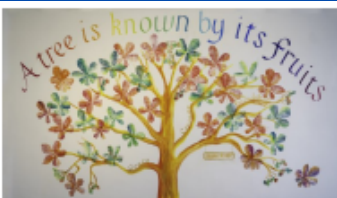
Infant School 95.5%

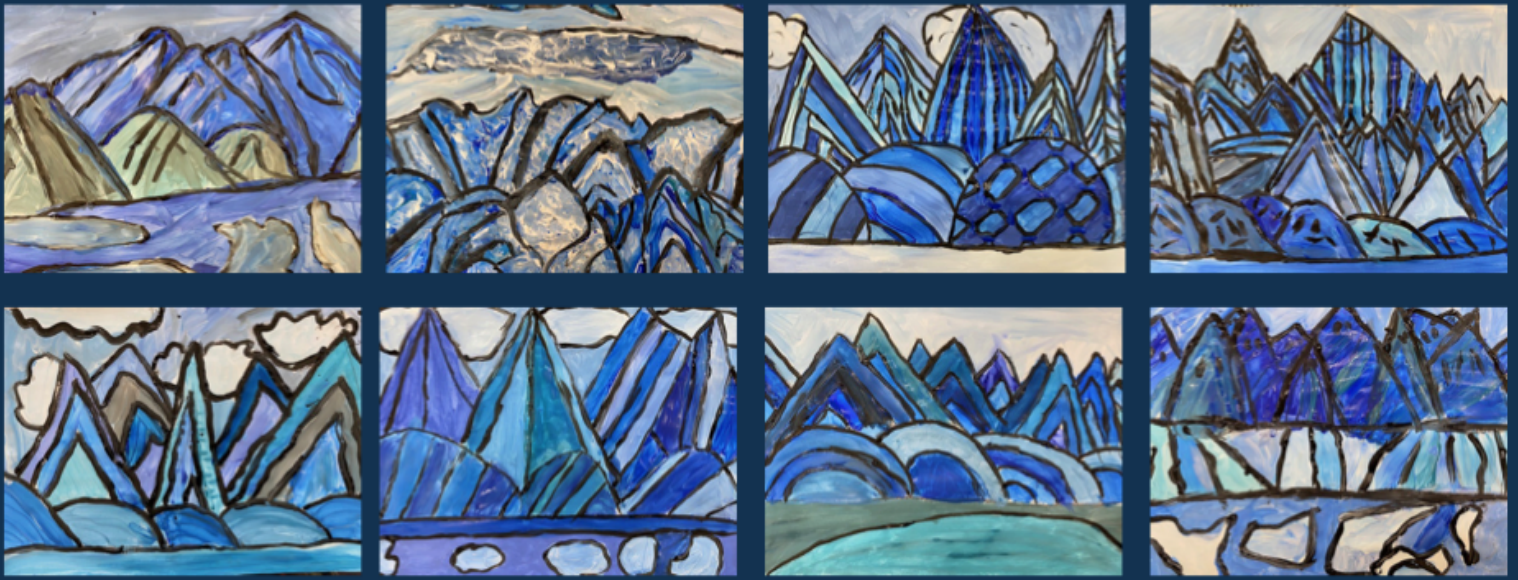
