We are only back two weeks and yet so much has been accomplished. Our children in KS1 have finished their SATS and this week sees the end of the Year 4 Times Table Check and Year 1 Phonics Screening as well.

Mandarin Lessons

Our Year 6 children have also begun a five-week programme in Mandarin! As we are a feeder school for The Piggott School, who follow a Mandarin Excellence Programme, we were offered a free course as an introduction to the Chinese language which, unsurprisingly, Mrs Pontet and her team leapt at! The children have live lessons, accessed online, each Monday morning.

Last Wednesday, a select group of around twenty Year 5/6 musicians took part in a musical workshop with Berkshire Chamber Orchestra. They had great fun composing alongside the professionals and were invited along to a concert the following Saturday watch their piece be performed. Our professional visitors were impressed with all the children's enthusiasm and commitment.



Quad Kids

Ms O'Byrne and I had the privilege of accompanying a team of Year 5 children to the Quad Kids athletics last Friday morning at Palmer Park Stadium. Each child participated in four events - 75m sprint, 600 m race, long jump and howler (a mini javelin style activity). There were five other Wokingham schools in attendance in the morning and more competing in the afternoon. It was very professional and very hot and our children were incredible. They competed extremely well in all events but more than that, they behaved with the Grace, Courage and Friendship we hold so dear.

As well as busy children, we have busy parents who are working flat out to produce an amazing Summer Fair **this Saturday** on the Infant School field.
