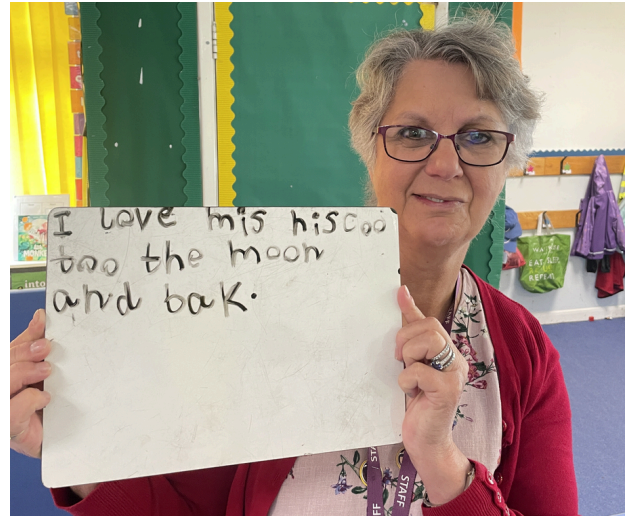

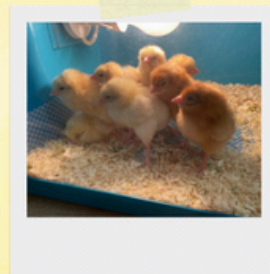


# GINGERBREAD COOKIES
